1. Introduction

The body text should be in Font Size 14 (Regular), with line spacing of (1.15). Use justified paragraph alignment to ensure a clean layout. Page margins must be set to 2.5 cm on all sides (Top, Bottom, Left, and Right).

2. Methodology and Tools

This section outlines the research approach, methodology, and tools (including AI applications or models) employed to conduct the study.

3. Results (Tables, Figures, and Equations)

Results should be presented objectively without interpretation. Tables and figures must be cited in the text before their appearance.

A. Tables

Tables should be numbered sequentially as they appear in the text. The table title, including the number, must be placed above the table, centered, and typed in Font Size 12 (Bold). The first row (Header) should be in Font Size 11(Bold), while the internal data should be in Font Size 11 (Regular). Tables must be in an "Open Style" (no vertical lines), as shown in Table (1)

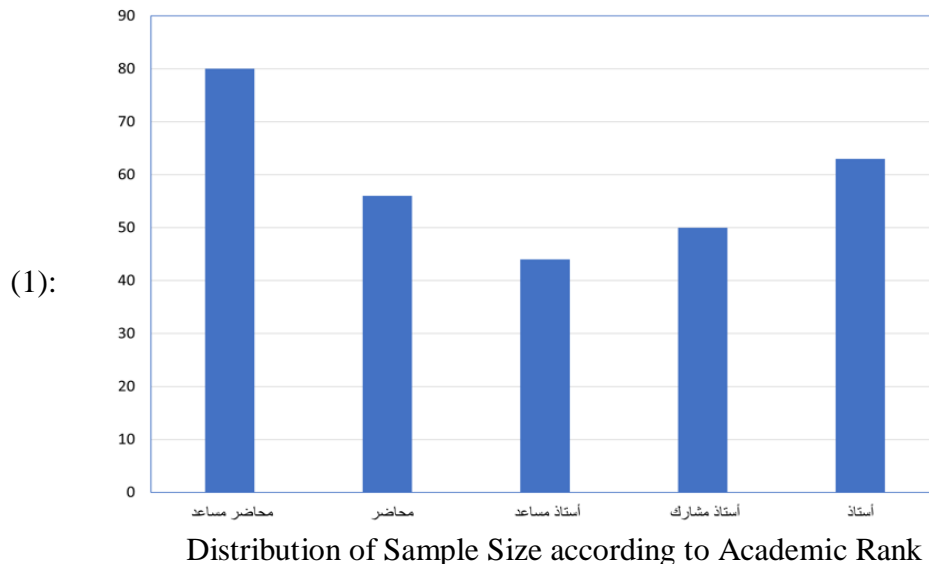

References must be listed alphabetically by the first author's last name. Titles should be in Italics.

Appendix 1:

Using Digital Software for Reference Management

A. Inserting Indirect Citations:

When using digital software (Mendeley, Zotero, or EndNote), place the cursor where you want the citation, click the **(Insert Citation)** feature within the Word "References" tab, and the software will format it automatically.

B. Inserting Direct Citations (Adding Page Numbers):

1. Insert the reference using the **Insert Citation** feature.

2. Once the citation appears in Word, click on it.
3. The software window (Mendeley or Zotero) will open; click on the reference within that window and type the page number in the **(Page)** field.
4. Click **(OK)**, and the software will automatically add the page number and format it according to the Harvard system.

C. Generating the Final Reference List (Bibliography):
After finishing the research and citing all sources in the text, follow these steps to insert the final list:

1. Go to the end of the research paper (the "References" section).
2. From the (References) tab in Word, specifically within the used software tool (Mendeley or Zotero), click on the **(Insert Bibliography)** feature.
3. The software will automatically pull all cited references from the text, arrange them alphabetically, and format them according to the Harvard system in one step.
